SIMNARD stalked the pacesetter under strong restraint, closed up outside the leader on the far turn, bid late turn and gained a narrow lead and held the advantage to the wire under a steady drive. COOL GATOR set a reserved pace, was pressured on the far turn, was headed at the top of the stretch but was very game to the end. SLIGOVITZ raced off the pace, quickened on the far turn to close the gap, rallied five-wide through the stretch but hung late. SOLITAIRE, in range, chased into the stretch, was under an all out drive but evened out in the late stages. DAYLIGHT EXPRESS, in range, chased four-wide into the stretch but flattened out midstretch. COBOTOWN RON, well back early, angled six-wide closing late turn then lacked a serious stretch response.
