### Footnotes

SLOT HAPPY broke sharply and sprinted to an unchallenged lead, held a clear advantage to deep stretch and was all out holding off a fast closing GO DIABLO. The latter was in hand three wide, roused in the drive and rallied belatedly. DARING HEIST was slow early just off the rail, roused on the turn and came between horses entering the stretch, then closed willingly in the drive. TORRANTULA was unhurried early just off the rail, but lacked a late response. COLONIAL WARMTH was hustled along chasing the early leader from the rail, then tired. ENIGMATIC was void of early speed off the rail and never rallied. KRAYOLA was hustled along between horses, then tired on the turn and dropped back. LIGHT MAHOGANY was hustled along four wide, then dropped back on the turn.
