TEEWEE'S HOPE was slow early and trailed the field, swung wide on the second turn and circled the field, then got up in the final strides after a long drive. SENSIBLE pressed the early pace just off the rail, assumed command on the second turn and opened a clear lead in the drive, but could not hold off the winner. SUPERTRAMP was allowed to settle in the two path stalking the early pace, then roused in the three path and closed the gap in the stretch. WAWOTA set the early pace in hand, then faltered on the second turn and dropped back. FLYING LEA stalked the early pace inside of rivals, then dropped back on the second turn.
