Footnotes

FEATHERS was void of early speed in the two path, came four wide in upper stretch and got up in the final strides under steady pressure. SHEILA'S PROSPECT was allowed to settle outside of rivals, rallied in the four path on the turn and assumed command in the drive, but could not hold off the winner. MISS SWEEP was void of early speed inside of rivals, roused between horses in upper stretch and closed willingly along the inside. MARISA GO was unhurried early in the two path, got stuck behind a wall of horses entering the stretch, then swung to the outside and finished well. EL PRADO ESSENCE was away alertly and stalked the early pace in the three path, drew even at the quarter pole, but weakened in the stretch. PRESS EXCLUSIVE was hustled along between horses in the backstretch, then dropped back in the stretch. QUICK BLUE stalked the early pace inside of rivals and lacked a late response and dropped back. SPORTS FLASHY was close up between horses in the early going, then dropped back on the turn. DREAMS GO BYE sprinted to the early lead and set the pace in hand, then faltered in upper stretch and faded. LIGHTNING PACE reared at the start and received an unfair start. Following the race there was a Stewards' inquiry for possible infractions at the start. After reviewing the tapes the Stewards ruled that LIGHTNING PACE received an unfair start and was declared a non-starter.
