Footnotes

BELIEVER'S LADY, rated early, closed outside the field late turn, rallied six-wide in the stretch and got up late under a drive. RICH ERA, whose rider did not carry a stick, showed early speed, set the pace, quickened on the far turn, was still clear in the stretch but failed to contain the winner in the late stages. TWILIGHT LANGSTAR showed brief speed and settled, remained unhurried still in range to the turn, closed six-wide into the stretch, was blocked briefly

upper stretch then rallied when clear. TACTICAL, in range, closed late turn, rallied gamely but hung late. YONA raced off the pace, was hustled between horses late turn, encountered traffic upper stretch, was game but evened out late. HIP HIP HOORAY raced midpack between horses, was hustled along the rail late turn then evened out in deep stretch. ESSA'S HONOR, in range between horses, was hustled into the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. CRYING THE BLUES, well back early, was hustled two-wide late turn then lacked a strong closing response. GABRIELLE'S CHARM raced in range, was hustled on the turn, came six-wide into the stretch then tired in the final furlong. SUSAN'S THUNDER, well back early, closed outside rivals late turn then lacked a rally. ABIRA raced off the pace, closed four-wide late turn then flattened out in the final furlong. MARIA BONITA, up close early, chased hard on the turn then tired in the stretch. SAINT PARASKEVY closed along the rail on the backstretch, stalked the pace into the turn then backed away.
