PROMISCUOUS pressed the pace early and took a short lead on the backstretch, shook clear on the turn then held sway under a drive. LEESON STREET LADY stalked the pace, was hustled three-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch, was determined, but hung. BEAR'S SONG, off slowly, closed quickly angling from the fourth path to the rail through the turn and finished all out inside rivals. SLICK PHILLY, in range, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then flattened out in midstretch. ESSENCES BEST had brief speed and was headed, dropped back at the turn then lacked a rally. RIDE THE GALE forced the pace, chased on the turn then tired approaching the top of the stretch. MISS ECHO DURING, off slowly, settled well off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn but never reached contention.
