Footnotes

RAINCOATS'NTUXEDOS was sent to the early lead, set the pace, drew off in the stretch and held sway, driving. BRANDYMAN stalked the pace, chased four-wide late turn then finished determinedly and held the place. EXFACTOR raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide late turn then finished gamely outside. ORO VERO stalked the rail, chased from the top of the stretch then flattened out in the late stages. LIFE FACTOR settled off the pace, chased two-wide into the stretch but never reached contention. TOM JOY, well back early, circled two to five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but flattened out. MARCHOSO stalked the pace, was hustled two and three-wide on the turn then tired in the final furlong.
