VALID ANTHEM was hustled along inside of rivals, angled outside of the early leader DEPUTY'S IRISH LAS midway through the turn and assumed command in upper stretch, then drew clear under steady pressure. DEPUTY'S IRISH LAS was rushed to the early lead from just off the rail, could not hold off the winner entering the stretch, but was a clear second. COME HOME CATHY stalked the early pace between horses, raced three wide on the turn and finished evenly in the drive. DUCHESS OF DOMASCA was in hand along the rail, roused at the quarter pole and finished with a mild rally. NATURE CHANT was void of early speed inside of rivals, made a mild bid along the rail, but was never a threat. PROMISING WEST was slow early and never rallied. NATIONOFLITIGATION was hustled along outside of rivals, then dropped back on the turn. NO HOLD ON ME was close up between horses, then faded in the stretch.
