,VELVET SNOW stalked from the third path, bid between rivals upper stretch and drove clear then held CLUBAY safe under right and left-handed encouragement. CLUBAY, well back early, closed along the third path through the turn, launched a wide rally upper stretch, was all out but could not get by the leader. MENIFEEQUE raced midpack along the second path, angled out at the top of the stretch then steadied slightly and finished all out. VAGANOVA stalked from the second path, was blocked late turn and at the top of the stretch then evened out. KIRLAN trailed early, saved ground, closed mildly in the stretch and did not menace. MARYFIELD raced prominently along the rail, vied on the turn then yielded upper stretch. STONINGTON, also prominent from the outset, dueled between foes on the turn then yielded upper stretch. PLAMOR PRINCESS, well back racing just off the rail, swung wide at the top of the stretch but lacked a rally. WARM RAIN raced forwardly outside two others, dueled on the turn but tired at the top of the stretch.
