Footnotes

BLUSHING BRAT, always in touch, came four to seven-wide through the turn, responded in the stretch, swept by the leader a 16th out and drew away under light handling. BEAR CAMP, in range, was hustled six-wide into the stretch and finished determinedly. MOBIL DREAMER, rated off the pace, angled five to seven-wide on the turn then rallied late outside. SCRAM DIGGITY pressed the pace, drove to a clear lead at the top of the stretch but failed to stave off his rivals and tired. BOXING RING stalked the pace, angled three to five-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out. LET'S GO BEAR, rated early, came four-wide through the turn, was hustled into the stretch but did not threaten. MOLINARO FORT pulled early, came three-wide through the

turn, chased into the stretch but flattened out with a 16th to run. COMMANDER TATE raced off the pace, was hustled along angling from three to five-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. POETIC SOUL showed early speed, was under serious pressure on the turn, yielded at the top of the stretch and tired. HARRY WALLBANGER was hustled from off the pace, came two-wide through the turn but never reached contention. DANISH SPIRIT, rated off the pace, raced three and four-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. BEAR'S SPEEDSTER stalked the pace early then faded on the turn and showed no late response.
