ROYAL EGBERT sprinted clear from the outset, set a reserved pace then widened through the stretch under a hand ride. HAWK'S A BLUR raced in midpack, was hustled two-wide on the turn then finished gamely in vain. THE BULL GOT SHOT stalked the pace, chased three-wide late turn but was unable to gain in the stretch. CORBELLI settled off the pace, chased three and four-wide on the turn but never reached contention. BOW BELL REEF raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide on the turn then failed to menace. MOBILIST stalked the pace, chased from the rail late turn then flattened out in the late stages. TWO OH ONE stalked the pace, chased two-wide late turn then flattened out in the final furlong. FOREST FOUNTAIN raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. MERCY STREET settled off the pace, saved ground but tired in the stretch.
