Footnotes

TWO WONDERS raced in midpack, closed five-wide late turn, swept by the leader upper stretch and widened under a hand ride. TAPIA settled off the pace, was hustled angling from the second path to five-wide through the turn then finished all out through the stretch. CLASSICAL HUMOUR, in range, chased four-wide on the turn, led briefly at the top of the stretch, was passed and chased to the end. I FLY HIGH raced in midpack, was hustled from the rail to three-wide on the turn and finished gamely in vain. BLUES DANCING led early, was headed midway of the backstretch, regained the lead early turn, set a pressured pace, was headed at the top of the stretch and flattened out. ADMITIT settled off the pace, angled three-wide to five-wide late turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out. L'AVENUE stalked the pace, chased three-wide on the turn and flattened out in the stretch. ALAMANDA DRIVE forced the pace, took a short lead midbackstretch, was headed early turn, forced the issue to the stretch and tired.
