SOMETHING EXTRA led early, was pressured on the backstretch, quickened on the turn and drew away then was all out to hold in the stretch. COURT OF THE REALM, in touch between rivals, chased angling from the rail to three-wide late turn, launched an all out charge in the stretch and was gaining late. RUN TO THE BANK settled off the pace, closed under a ride on the turn, chased three-wide into the stretch and rallied gamely. BEAR'S CHILL, in range five-wide, chased late turn then evened out in the late stages. BIG BAND SOUND pressed the pace early, chased on the turn and evened out midstretch. D'S WANDO stalked the pace from between foes, was roused four-wide on the turn but showed no response.
