MAGIC BROOMSTICK settled off the early pace, was hustled three to five-wide on the far turn, finished full of run in the middle of the track and was up in the final strides. ALL STAR HEART raced in midpack, closed four-wide late turn, bid a furlong out, gained a short lead but was caught near the wire. CHOKUREI (IRE) broke inward and bumped FOREST UPROAR, settled in midpack, chased hard on the far turn then rallied gamely along the rail. SILENT MOON set a reserved pace, was collared upper stretch and yielded grudgingly after a brief duel. POETIC KID settled off the pace, angled out late turn, chased six-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. MY PERFECT TEN raced in midpack, was hustled five-wide on the far turn, chased into the stretch and finished all out between horses. FOREST UPROAR, bumped at the start, settled off the pace, was hustled from the rail on the far turn then evened out in deep stretch. INDIAN POND raced in midpack, chased four-wide on the final turn but never reached contention. NIKKIS BOLD GELATO, prominent early,

forced the pace on the far turn then tired upper stretch. TEE GAME settled off the pace, chased two and three-wide on the turn but lacked a closing response. DIXIE CHICKEN, in range, stalked the pace to the far turn, chased to the stretch and tired in the final furlong.
