EL PRADO ESSENCE broke sharply and pressed the early pace, assumed command on the turn and drew clear in the stretch under a hand ride, was much the best. BAR U MOKWA was void of early speed off the rail, roused between horses on the turn, came four wide in the drive and got up for place. PLENTY O' WOMAN was rushed to the early lead inside of rivals, opened a clear lead approaching the far turn, but could not stay with the winner and just failed for place. FOUND TREASURE was unhurried early, roused four wide on the turn and finished with a mild rally. VIXEN STAR was allowed to settle inside of rivals, roused on the turn, but was never a threat. I BEAT THE TORNADO broke slowly and to the right, was then hustled along on the rail and never a threat. DEADLY VICES was hustled along pressing the early pace between horses, then tired in the drive. DONNYBROOK LASS was hustled along just off the rail, then dropped back on the turn. SWEEPING BEAUTY showed little and was never a factor.
