BEAUTIFUL BELLE broke sharply and set the early pace off the rail, turned away TIME TO DECIDE entering the stretch and drew clear under steady pressure. The latter pressed the early pace outside of rivals, loomed boldly on the turn, but could not stay with the winner in the drive. MISS SWEEP was hustled along inside of rivals, roused on the turn, but was in tight at the quarter pole, slipped through entering the stretch and finished with a mild rally. WAGER'S JOY was unhurried early inside of rivals, roused three wide in the stretch and made a mild bid. KARAOKE PRINCESS was allowed to settle early, roused three wide on the turn, but failed to respond. ISLAND LOVER was void of early speed outside of rivals, angled out in upper stretch, but was never a threat. DUTCH APPROVAL was slow early along the rail and never a factor. SCREEN HAPPY pressed the early pace between horses, saved ground on the turn, then faded in the stretch. SPECTACULAR VIEW was hustled along between horses, then faded in the drive.
