Footnotes

MOMENT OF PEACE stalked the pace in hand, closed three-deep into the stretch, bid a furlong out then outfinished DIABLESSE in a duel from the 1/8 pole. DIABLESSE was unhurried early, closed three-wide late turn, came four-wide into the stretch, challenged a furlong out, dueled to the wend but was outfinished. EARTHQUAKE RIDE raced midpack, moved off the rail late turn then rallied determinedly outside rivals. PALACE UPRISING close early, bid inside FANCY DRINKS into the pool, held a slight lead then drew clear past midturn, had command to the final furlong and tired. CRUISING EXECUTIVE stalked from the rail then hung in the stretch. FANCY DRINKS held a short lead on the backstretch, was engaged and headed entering the turn, forced the issue from outside DIABLESSE then gave way approaching the top of the stretch. S N J'S DESIRE trailed along the rail and lacked a rally.
