Footnotes

DAKOTA FREEWAY stalked the pace, closed three-wide and bid midturn, vied into the stretch, drove clear upper stretch and was taken in hand in the late stages. HIGHLAND GLORY moved up quickly to duel on the backstretch, shook clear entering the turn, was joined midturn, dueled to the stretch but was no match. EXECUTIVE SHANE settled early, closed three-deep on the turn and finished gamely to be best of the rest. VALID AND BRIGHT, well back early, saved ground but never reached contention. JUDITH'S ROY stalked the pace, was sent after the leaders between rivals entering the turn, chased to the stretch then flattened out. ARCHIEMAN was hustled to the early lead but was joined in a duel, vied briefly, gave way nearing the turn and faded. SWITCH TO FITCH was always well back, raced four-wide on the turn and lacked a rally. WHENYOU DANCEWITHME dueled to the turn then gave way and faded along the rail and tired badly.
