Footnotes

CAVAICHI, rated in midpack, closed late turn, bid a furlong out, dueled to the wire and prevailed under a drive. MAVERICK MAN pressed the pace, chased on the turn, launched a determined drive along the rail and just missed. SOUTHERN LEGEND raced off the pace, was hustled three to five-wide on the turn, bid a furlong out, dueled but was outfinished. TAKIDDM forced the pace, took a short lead into the turn, set a pressured pace, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was engaged a furlong out and yielded. EDDINGTON LIMIT stalked the pace, chased four-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. FINDING THE TIME showed brief speed under pressure, was headed late backstretch, forced the pace through the turn, chased into the stretch and tired. CRAFTY MCNABB, rated off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention.
