CAPTAIN RAUCOUS raced off the pace, trailed four and five-wide through the turn, swung out for the stretch drive, rallied widest, was full of run and got up just in time. GAS N DASH stalked the pace, chased two-wide on the turn, bid a furlong out, drove to the lead, was all out but was caught at the wire. MOLINARO WARRIOR, in touch, chased hard four-wide late turn then finished all out between foes. CONFLICTING REPORT raced in midpack, angled out on the turn, launched his rally, chased gamely but was outkicked. RING OF GREATNESS raced off the pace, was hustled three to six-wide through the turn then rallied from far back. DANCE TO MY BEAT set the pace and was under a ride late turn, was headed in the final furlong but gave way grudgingly. EVEN, squeezed back at the start, was rated off the pace, chased five-wide on the turn then evened out in the late stages. TRIP PERMIT showed brief speed then stalked the pacesetter, chased on the turn, challenged a furlong out but failed to sustain the bid. YOU DON'T PASS raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide on the turn, chased hard into the stretch then evened out late. MR. ROD settled in midpack, chased three-wide on the turn then flattened out in the late stages. BEAR'S PROSPECTOR raced in midpack, chased two-wide on the turn then evened out midstretch. PAYNES GOLD, rated off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch.
