CRAWFORD COUNTY pressed the pace and was between foes on the turn, kept battling only to weaken in the final furlong. ESSON LAKE in striking distance throughout, bid between in the drive the was outfinished. ASPETUCK HILL off the pace then between foes into the stretch, bid from there but needed more. EXECUTIVE SHERRI saved ground and did not menace. FOREST GLITTER had speed to lead into the turn, battled from there then backed away and tired. WAVE BABY WAVE raced in mid pack while in the hunt, then did not fire.
