CLASSIC BRYCE settled off the pace, trailed the gained outside on the turn to bid three wide into the stretch, kept the strong rally going and ran rivals down to prevail. CANADIAN FLAG off the early pace, gained and bid 3-wide into the far turn, was between rivals into the stretch and in the game then outfinished by the outside runner. BLUEDACIOUS broke tardily then was inside early and off the pace, angled out and had a belated stretch run to best the rest. MALIBU TIDE stalked the leaders and remained a factor on the turn but lacked a serious off the rail stretch bid. POLITICAL FEVER unhurried early, had a mild gain then evened out in the run to the wire. LIFE FACTOR vied inside and was a factor into the stretch turn then faltered inside of foes. SEWANEE stalked from the inside then backed away and trailed on the turn. REIMER had inside speed and vied for five furlong then tired and was all done. MAXIMUM EXCHANGE tracked the leader into the far turn from off the rail then faded.
