### Footnotes

LOVE TO BATTLE kept close then vied on the turn from outside of foe, went clear in the drive then just held off late outside rival. THATBOATHASSAILED never far back, kept in striking distance then bid willingly outside the winner, came on late but missed. CRUSHIN HARD had an inside close up trip then bid inside in the drive but came up short in a good effort. ROSEVILLE hit gate at the break and was off the pace, gained ground but failed to threaten the top three. WESSIE THE CAT failed to menace after being in mid pack in the early going. OUTDOOR EXEC between foes, off the rail and off the pace, lacked a bid. SNEAKY MONEY gained ground after trailing into the first turn then evened out when the serious running began. MOLINARO FORT HEAL had inside speed to show the way, kept on the engine into the stretch turn then tired inside. ACEUPPHILSLEEVE was off a step slow, moved into contention in the early going, could not keep up and faded. ROBADO backed away after being up close early then trailed the field home by a good margin.
