Footnotes

SANTERRA sped to the early lead and set the pace in hand, then drew clear on the second turn and widened the margin in the drive under intermittent urging. DEPUTY CURES BLUES was fanned a bit wide entering the first turn and allowed to settle three wide in the backstretch, then roused on the second turn and closed willingly. FANCY DRINKS chased the winner from the three path, then weakened in the stretch. PIERSIXER was allowed to settle between horses, then roused on the turn and made a mild bid, but was never a threat. GOOD KNIGHT STORY was slow early, then finished with a mild bid well off the rail. MELTING POINT was void of early speed and never factor. FRITZY HOUR pressed the early pace from the inside, then dropped back in the backstretch. BIT SHEE BELIEVER was void of early speed along the rail and never rallied.
