Footnotes

YOUR ROUND, well back early, angled out closing late turn, rallied six-wide and got up late under a drive. GENIUS KINSHASA raced midpack, closed six-wide late turn, gained the lead midstretch and moved clear then failed to hold the winner safe late. KNIGHT'S CAUSE raced off the pace, closed four-wide into the stretch and finished determinedly between foes. RED LEADER raced midpack, saved ground on the turn, came off the rail upper stretch and finished determinedly. SKIPADATE raced off the pace, angled out closing late turn then rallied belatedly. LIFES NOT A BREEZE stalked the pace, closed three-wide late turn, chased into the stretch but evened out. LIFE GOES ON led early, set a reserved pace, was headed midstretch and tired. PIT ALLEY settled well back, raced two-wide on the turn, closed from the top of the stretch then flattened out. LITTLE RED CHRIS, rated in range, angled from two-wide to four-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. BOURBON BAY, in range early, was hustled angling from three to six-wide on the turn but lacked a rally. SEE U AT THE TOP pulled hard up and was up close on the backstretch, chased late turn then tired midstretch.
