Footnotes

COPY CAT was never far back, roused between horses around the turn, moved to the rail in mid stretch and was full of run drawing clear at the end. UNCLE WOGER pressed the pace inside of rivals, assumed command in upper stretch and drifted off the rail, could not hold off the winner in the drive. SMART ASCOT saved ground in the early going, closed the gap along the rail through the turn, was in tight in the drive, but was never steadied. INCINDIARY DEVICE was rushed to the lead between horses setting a pressured pace, steadied mildly in mid stretch, but was tiring. AMICUS CURIAE pressed the early pace between horses while 3 wide, dropped back around the turn, then passed tiring rivals in the stretch. IRIE BLUE stalked the pace 3 wide, drew even around the turn, then tired in the drive. REGAL ASCOT stalked the pace 4 wide, drew even around the turn, then faded in the drive.
