JUDGE ME IFYOUCAN was allowed to settle inside of rivals, roused between horses on the second turn, then moved inside of the leaders in the drive and prevailed under strong pressure. MISS JOKER was unhurried early in the three path, came four wide in upper stretch and assumed command in the drive, but could not hold off the winner. ONE FOR ROSE angled to the rail in the early going and saved ground throughout pressing the pace, battled gamely throughout and held well. BORNTOBELOVED was away alertly and set the early pace in hand, then stopped in mid stretch and dropped back. CALEDON COLLEEN was close up four wide, made a bid four wide on the second turn, but flattened out in the drive. GO DIABLO stalked the early pace three wide, but lacked a late response. REGAL N' CLASSY stumbled at the start and spotted the field three lengths, then raced outside of rivals and was never a factor. MYSTERIOUS ANGEL was well rated in the three path, then dropped back on the second turn.
