BLONDE WISDOM gained contention nearing the far turn, closed quickly and bid late turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch and prevailed under a drive. VICTORIAN ROSE led into the first turn, set a reserved pace, was headed at the top of the stretch and chased the new leader home. PECTORALIS MAJOR broke in the air, raced well back, was under a ride on the far turn then evened out but was best of the rest. DAME ELIZA, well back early, closed three-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. ELECTRIC SKY raced midpack, was roused between foes late turn and did not threaten. EMPRESS PEGASUS raced off the pace from between horses, lacked a rally. LIL'MISS MISCHIEF, in touch early, faded on the far turn. BID FOR SILVER stalked to the far turn, chased briefly and tired. SHERRY'S ATTORNEY trailed throughout.
