LIL' SASHA forced the pace, bid into the turn, edged clear then held sway under a drive. THEATRE QUEEN raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn, angled out in the stretch and rallied gamely. TIP YOUR HAT set a pressured pace, was joined at the turn, vied briefly, was cleared approaching the top of the stretch and chased to the wire. MUTTAK BAY chased from off the pace, was roused late turn and finished willingly. DON'TGETMADALEXIS, in range, chased on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. THE QUEEN'S REIGN stalked the pace, dropped back late turn but finished well although not a threat. BELLE OF THE NILE, in range early, chased from the rail on the turn then tired midstretch. SAPPHIRE STAR was hustled from off the pace then tired in the stretch.
