JENNA'S WABBIT led early and set the pace well in hand, quickened upper stretch and was lightly handled then finished under restraint. TRUE EXECUTIVE stalked the pace, was roused five-wide late turn and was all out through the stretch. KING CITY pressed the pace, chased hard into the stretch along the inside but did not bid and evened out. COURTVILLE raced off the pace, chased four-wide late turn then finished gamely along the rail. ONE MORE DEAL raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn then flattened out in deep stretch. DON'T SEND A BOY, rated off the pace, chased along the rail on the turn then tired upper stretch. FLYING ECHO, off slowly, was used briefly then stalked the pace to the turn, chased, but tired at the top of the stretch.
