### Footnotes

AWESOME ECLIPSE, in range, angled in from the third path and bid along the rail late turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch, drifted out in the final furlong after being encouraged with left-handed urging then held sway under a strong hand ride. DRAGO'S BEST stalked the pace, chased late turn, launched a bid in the stretch but was forced out by the winner through the final furlong. SHOTINTHEFOG raced off the pace, closed along the rail through the turn then finished gamely inside. MEADOW MAGIC sprinted clear early, set the pace, was headed at the top of the stretch and chased to the end. JOHNNY LA RUE settled in midpack, came three to five-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch and rallied mildly. TOP PROSPECT raced in midpack, was hustled on the turn then evened out in the final sixteenth. LIGHTHOUSE SOUND raced in midpack, chased three and four-wide on the turn but lacked a closing response. NATIVE GOLD raced in midpack, was hustled two-wide late turn then flattened out in the stretch. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN AND A CLAIM OF FOUL LODGED BY THE RIDER OF DRAGO'S BEST AGAINST AWESOME ECLIPSE FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH RESULTED IN AWESOME ECLIPSE BEING DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST AND PLACED SECOND.
