SPANISH DECREE was allowed to settle outside of rivals, roused four wide entering the stretch and prevailed under steady pressure. MOUNTAIN ORCHID stalked the early pace three wide, drew even on the turn and opened a clear lead in the drive, but could not hold off the winner. MULRAINY pressed the early pace inside of rivals, then dropped back slightly on the turn, but battled gamely and held well. HEYAHOHOWDY was allowed to settle just off the rail, then closed the gap on the turn and finished evenly. TACKY AFFAIR was unhurried early three wide and lacked a late response. EMBOSSED was void of early speed just off the rail, saved ground on the turn and lacked a late response. WHISTLING MAID set a pressured pace between horses, then dropped back in the stretch. SUSAN GRACEY broke in the air and was never a factor.
