Footnotes

TOP NOTCH LADY stalked the pace, closed four-wide on the backstretch, bid into the turn, shook clear late turn and widened under a hand ride. MOTEL DANCING raced midpack, closed along the rail on the far turn and was all out through the stretch. SEVERN SOUND well back early, closed four-wide on the far turn but evened out. UNTUTTABLE GAL had brief speed under a hold, settled and stalked the pace close up, took command entering the fare turn, dueled inside TOP NOTCH LADY and was no match for that one late turn and evened out. OUR MADISON raced midpack three-wide and lacked a rally. IMELDA OH broke inward but showed speed from the rail, dueled with TWO STEPPER but gave way late backstretch and faded. TWO STEPPER had speed, dueled to late backstretch, wore down IMELDA OH but was headed by a third rival, chased briefly and tired. BETWEEN DRINKS was always well back along the rail. FRIVOLETTE trailed from off the rail and was never a factor.
