D BOLD RULER, in touch along the rail, closed late turn, rallied inside and got up midstretch under a drive. SEVERI, well back early, closed three then four-wide on the turn and finished willingly. GONE TRAJECTORY stalked the pace, closed three then four-wide on the turn and was all out in the stretch. PAIGE THE GENERAL stalked the pace, chased late turn then was all out in the stretch. HERLUF led three-wide early, set a strongly reserved pace, held to midstretch and tired. NEAR NOISE, well back early, swung wide at the top of the stretch, lugged in then tendered a late run. IT'S LIKE THIS raced off the pace two-wide, never reached contention. AGNICO raced midpack, angled three-wide to five-wide late turn then tired in the stretch. RETALIATE raced midpack, saved ground, was ease at the top of the stretch, came back lame and was vanned off.
