STAKES Coronation Futurity S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS, FOALED IN CANADA. Scale Weight: Colts and Geldings, 122 lbs.; Fillies, 119 lbs. By subscription of \$20 each for mares served in 2004 to accompany the nomination by February 1st, 2005 (1249 nominated). To continue eligibility of foals of mares nominated, the following payments must be made: February 1st, 2006, \$75 (541 remained eligible); February 1st, 2007 \$150 (275 remained eligible); August 1st, 2007, \$300 (88 remained eligible); and an additional \$2,500 when making final entry at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. Horses not originally nominated to the 2007 Coronation Futurity may be made eligible by a payment of a late nomination fee of \$7500 on or before September 15th, 2007 (1 supplement). All monies received to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. \$75,000 of this purse has been provided through the Thoroughbred Improvement Program. Plus up to \$12,450 Ontario Sire/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards.

KESAGAMI set a reserved pace, drew off a long lead, turned back DEPUTIFORMER upper stretch then held under a drive. COOL GATOR stalked two-wide, closed three-wide on the far turn, angled out through the stretch and was gaining under a full out rally. DEPUTIFORMER raced off the pace, swung four-wide and closed quickly late turn, launched a bid upper stretch but failed to get up and hung in the late stages. GO IN PEACE stalked from the rail, was hustled on the final turn, chased to the stretch then evened out. DONERAILE GEM rated early, saved ground, was hustled along the second path on the far turn but never reached contention. GIANT GAMBIT stalked the pace, was hustled along the rail on the far turn and tired in the stretch.
