LET'S GET ROCKIN unhurried in the early going, was outside foes and gaining into the stretch turn, rallied widest in the drive and was up in time. WANDO'S APPEAL had a wide trip into the stretch then angled in in the run to the wire, split foes and finished with good energy. PIVOTAL MOMENT had speed to vie for the lead, battled on the turn then led in the drive, was outfinished but completed a solid try. DISTINCT BY DESIGN raced wide throughout, gained on the turn then rallied wide and willingly but was outgunned to the wire. WHY DAT in mid pack, bid inside into the stretch and finished off a good

effort. WHISPERED LEGEND had speed to be outside and pressing the leader, battled on the turn then gave way. CHOMBO in the mix and a factor from off the rail on the turn, had no stretch kick. BATHSHEBA STATION raced well off the pace and was never a threat. LLEWELLYN chased and was in touch on the turn from off the rail then tired. CAIT'S APPLE JACK settled off the pace and had no rally. HIGHLAND MATT backed away after being in the hunt on the turn. ONE THOUSAND PLUS was off slow and never a factor.
