Footnotes

SPARKLE AND SHINE stalked the pace, quickened late turn then inherited the lead at the 1/4 pole, was clear in the stretch and held sway under a drive. SOTIQUE, in range, was hustled three to six-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and rallied gamely. OLIVIA'S SONG settled off the pace, chased three-wide late turn, was up close to the leader in the in the stretch and gamely in vain. THE QUEEN'S REIGN, rated in midpack, closed late turn, chased into the stretch and finished gamely. WHISPERING WALL, away slowly, raced off the pace in hand, was hustled four-wide on the turn then finished

determinedly. TWENTY BLACK settled in midpack, chased four to seven-wide on the turn and finished willingly. HIGHLAND FLARE settled well off the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn but never reached contention. TOTAL BLISS, in touch, chased five-wide late turn then evened out in midstretch. HOLY WINE dueled early, edged clear, bore out through the turn and relinquished the lead, chased upper stretch then evened out. ROCKABYEBABY showed brief speed then stalked the pace three-wide but tired late turn. BEST SELECT stalked the pace, faded along the rail from early turn and lacked a closing response. WHY SO SOON vied early then stalked the pace, backed away late turn and tired.
