IS IT COOL raced in the second flight behind a fast pace, closed on the turn, took command a furlong out and held sway under a hand ride. ZEE'S CURE, away alertly, settled in the second flight, closed four-wide late turn and finished determinedly. COMTESSE CRIMSON raced off the pace, closed four-wide late turn then finished all out. SO SOVEREIGN raced off the pace, closed from well back on the turn and rallied willingly outside. POLAR SURVIVOR, in the second flight, was hustled two-wide on the turn, angled out in the stretch, was finishing well but lost her path nearing the wire and had to be taken in hand in the final yards. ROCK'S SWEET THING, bothered at the start, raced well off the pace, was hustled on the turn and rallied late outside. EXECUTIVE DRIVEN raced in midpack, chased three-wide on the turn but never reached contention. BLUES DANCING sprinted to a long lead, set a fast pace, was tiring late turn and was through with a furlong to run. TOTAL BLISS raced in midpack, saved ground, was roused late turn but flattened out in the stretch. PROUD OF MY ROOTS settled in the second flight, closed along the rail late turn but flattened out in deep stretch. PEYTES DEED TOLIFE, always well off the pace, was hustled on the turn but lacked a rally. CARMALIZED PEACH raced in midpack and faded along the rail through the turn.
