Footnotes

PRIVATE EXTENSION was hustled along off the rail, drew even in the turn, assumed command in the drive and drew clear under intermittent urging. COMTESSE CRISTOL stalked the early pace along the rail, roused in upper stretch and finished well but was no match for the winner. UPROAR was unhurried early, roused between horses in the turn and finished with a mild rally. DASHING FASHION showed good early speed and set the pace along the rail but gave way at the 1/4 pole and dropped back. SUSPICIOUS MATTER was hustled along but dropped back in the backstretch then finished with a mild rally in the drive. RESOLUTE BAY was unhurried early between horses but lacked a late response and ran evenly. WHAT A FENISH was void of early speed off the rail, found her best stride late but was never a threat. PROMISING WEST raced close up 4 wide in the backstretch then dropped back in the turn. AMAZONIAN RACEKEY was void of early speed in the three path and never rallied. ROBYN'S SWEETEE was void of early speed, saved ground through the turn but was never a threat. ADAGIO CURESBLUES was unhurried early along the rail and never a threat.
