Footnotes

PLAYING FOOTSIE led quickly, widened on the backstretch, was under restraint to the stretch then held under a strong hand ride. ARROGANCE was unhurried early, raced four-wide throughout, closed late turn and was all out in the stretch. MIND READER stalked early then settled off the pace, moved from the rail to three-wide midturn and finished gamely. RAGING REDHEAD trailed early, raced three-wide, was roused late turn then finished willingly. FAR AND NEAR raced three-wide and evenly to the far turn, was roused approaching the stretch but flattened out. JANE B. A. well back early, saved ground and was never a serious threat. LADY CHRISTINE saved ground, closed into the far turn then evened out. CLASSICAL RUCKUS was always well back. DANCE THE GREEN stalked the pace but tired at the top of the stretch. SPICE IS NICE broke in the air, raced four-wide on the first turn, chased after the pacesetter on the far turn and tired.
