D'S LEGEND STORM closed from midpack late backstretch, pressed the duelers, bid four-wide at the top of the stretch, was headed, rebid a furlong out and prevailed under a drive. KID CANUCK, away alertly, led early, dueled from late backstretch, gained command at the top of the stretch, was engaged a furlong out and yielded grudgingly. ITS CHECKMATE raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn then rallied in the late stages. BECKY'S KITTEN, in range, was close up while five and six-wide on the turn, was determined in the stretch but evened out late. WILD MEMORIES stalked the pace, bid four-wide into the turn, dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased briefly and tired. WOODLAND FLUTE was well back early, raced three and four-wide on the turn but never reached contention. CASHININ ONA DREAM, in range early, closed on the backstretch, bid inside the leader nearing the turn, dueled, then tired at the top of the stretch.
