Footnotes

HAWKS GOT FIRE forced the pace, took the lead nearing the turn, shook clear quickly and set the pace then held sway under a hand ride. TAKE IT ALL set a pressured pace, was headed nearing the turn, chased to the end and held place. STAR EAGLE chased on the backstretch and turn then raced gamely through the stretch. SOROKOLITIS chased throughout and was best of the rest. BRAVE SKY raced off the pace, was hustled two and three-wide on the turn but never reached contention. COLONEL BY raced in midpack, chased four to six-wide through the turn but never reached contention. ELMO SHRUGS chased from midpack, was hustled four-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. TIAKI, well back early, was hustled five and six-wide through the turn but lacked a closing response. THE MENNONITE KID settled off the pace, chased two-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch.
