Footnotes

ACTING DEPUTY was well rated just off the rail in the early going, dueled inside of REDCARPETTREATMENT on the turn, put that one away in the drive and drew clear under steady pressure. BAISER D'AMOUR was slow early just off the rail, swung wide entering the stretch and closed fast getting up for place. FAR AND NEAR was void of early speed while saving ground, split horses entering the stretch and closed the gap in the drive, but flattened out in the late going. DIVINE ROCKETTE was allowed to settle between horses and lacked a late response. REDCARPETTREATMENT stalked the early pace from the outside, dueled on the turn, then tired in the stretch. MIND READER was allowed to settle outside of rivals and never rallied. DANCE LESSONS sped to the early lead in hand, then faded on the turn.
