KNAVE OF HEARTS stalked the pace, chased seven-wide into the stretch, bid a 16th out and drove clear. FLIM FLAM, in range, closed five-wide into the stretch, bid midstretch but was outfinished. NOT SO GRIEM, in range, chased five and six-wide on the turn, was up close in early stretch, was game but failed to lodge a bid. COOK'S LOOK raced off the pace, angled from five to seven-wide on the turn then rallied gamely outside. CLASSIC EXECUTIVE stalked the pace, was boxed in late turn, rallied, bid midstretch but was outkicked. OLD BUD raced well back, was hustled six-wide late turn then rallied late between foes. DON'T THINK TWICE was prominent from the early stages, dueled, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was headed a 16th out and tired. PANTASTIC, in range, was hustled along the rail late turn then evened out in the final furlong. PROMISING DANCER raced off the pace, angled from six-wide to eight-wide on the turn, rallied, but flattened out in deep stretch. ACED THE MOVES raced midpack,chased three and four-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. BEARS GOAL raced forwardly, dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased, but flattened out late. BERMUDA REEF, well back early, was hustled five-wide on the turn but never reached contention. HARD GRAFT, well back early, angled from three to six-wide on the turn

then flattened out in the final furlong. BOLT WEST stalked the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and tired.
