**Footnotes**

FORESTADOR moved up and dueled late backstretch and through the turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch then held, driving. TINKER raced off the pace, was hustled along three-wide, angled out upper stretch and rallied gamely. THE BULL GOT SHOT chased from between rivals, raced three and four-wide on the turn and finished determinedly. LOVE DESIGN was hustled to a short early lead, was headed and forced the pace then chased through the stretch. MAN O' METTLE, in range, chased four and five-wide on the turn then finished evenly. BEST OF AFFAIRS stalked the pace, chased late turn and finished all out along the rail. RED EAGLE raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn then rallied belatedly. PLEASURE PEAKS was close early, angled from five-wide to seven-wide to seven-wide but failed to menace. RODEO BOY settled off the pace, was hustled along five-wide then lacked a closing response. BARBASGO was hustled angling from six-wide to eight-wide on the turn but lacked a rally. DUNLOE raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. MCGILLICUDDY bid at the 1/2 mile pole, dueled on the turn, yielded at the top of the stretch and tired.
