BAY SWEETIE BABE pressed the pace three wide, gained the lead into the turn, and held well. SPIFFIE GAL bobbed at the break, raced inside, steadied in the backstretch, came off the rail on the turn, rallied four wide. ORIENTAL DOLL raced four wide, advanced mildly. SUNADIR broke inwards, advanced inside to make a bid on the turn, flattened out in the stretch. WOODEN SHIPS raced five wide, made a bid on the turn, weakened in the stretch. BALLYMALOE vied for the lead five wide, was three wide on the turn, and gave way. SPLITTHEDIFFERENCE vied for the lead four wide, dropped back on the turn. FOXY JEAN stalked the forced pace from off the rail, and had no menace. KAIN'S DEED broke slow, raced three wide. NYKEE was off the rail, and showed little. GLAD AS KNIGHT had a short lead early, was close up while six wide, and faded.
