BARBAREES HILL stalked the early pace from the three path, roused four wide on the turn and wore down rivals in the drive getting up in the final strides. NAKODA pressed the early pace outside of TOWER POWER, assumed command from that one entering the stretch and opened a clear lead, but could not hold off the winner. MISS IDA BELLE was pinched back at the start, but recovered quickly and chased the early leaders from the rail, continued strong and finished evenly in the drive. SOUTHERN SWEET was void of early speed, closed the gap inside of rivals in the drive, but was never a threat. HIGHLAND DREAM was unhurried early off the rail and never a threat. TOWER POWER was away alertly and set a pressured pace, then tired in the stretch and faded.
