FORTY CREEK, rated off the pace, closed outside horses on the far turn, rallied five-wide and got up late under a drive. TAP SHOW, off a step slowly, stalked four-wide, bid midway of the far turn, was headed at the top of the stretch, rebid and led briefly but failed to contain the winner in the late stages. STOLONBOY set a pressured pace, vied on the far turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch but yielded a sixteenth out. SKIP CODE, rated early in range, was hustled late on the far turn then finished gamely in vain. STORM THE CASTLE rated kindly, pressed the pace, launched a sharp bid into the far trn, dueled, then yielded at the top of the stretch. THUNDER WOLF, rated close up inside, forced the pace on the backstretch, chased on the far turn then flattened out. IT'S LIKE THIS, rated off the pace, closed on the far turn then lacked a strong late response. PAPA TIME, rated midpack between horses, chased on the far turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but had no response.
