SOMETHING EXTRA stalked the pace, chased late turn, bid upper stretch and drove clear in the final furlong. THE BOY'S RING dueled on the backstretch, was headed but rebid early turn, took command but yielded in the final furlong. GENERAL BROCK raced in midpack, closed six-wide late turn and was all out through the stretch. QUICK CODE settled off the pace, was hustled three to six-wide on the turn and finished all out. GUITAR SOLO raced in midpack, chased on the turn then flattened out stretch. SAY NO MORE dueled on the main track, led into the turn, was headed, chased to the stretch and flattened out.
