TURFISTE pressed the pace, chased on the turn, bid in the final furlong and edged ahead under a drive. MOLINARO WARRIOR was used briefly to gain the early lead, set a pressured pace, was engaged in the final furlong and gave way grudgingly. PAYTON'S VICTORY raced in midpack, was in range at the top of the stretch and finished determinedly. BAYLAND settled off the pace, chased on the turn then rallied between foes. ACCOMPLICE raced in midpack, saved ground, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. JET SET EXEC pressed the pace, chased hard three-wide on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. YOU DON'T PASS raced off the pace, chased five-wide into the stretch then finished all out. MAGNIFICENT TIGER raced off the pace, drifted out late turn, finished well but was not a threat. TRIP PERMIT was hustled along in range, chased four-wide on the turn then flattened out midstretch. OCCASIO settled off the pace, was hustled from the rail and two-wide on the turn but never reached contention. D' ARTAGNAN raced in midpack, angled in leaving the turn and flattened out along the rail. WILD SUNDAY (GB) always well back, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn and never reached contention. GULCH KNIGHT raced well off the pace, was hustled on the turn and never threatened.
